

NAME

`disdvi` – ‘disassemble’ a (p)TeX or XeTeX DVI file

SYNOPSIS

disdvi [-p][-u][-Eenc] [*dvi_file*].dvi]

disdvi -x [*xdv_file*].xdv]

disdvi -h

DESCRIPTION

disdvi interprets the contents of *dvi_file* or *xdv_file* printing the DVI commands and text in a human-readable ASCII/multibyte format on the standard output.

Options:

-p Handle ASCII pTeX dvi file.

-u Handle upTeX dvi file.

-Eenc Set output multibyte encoding. The enc argument ‘e’, ‘s’, ‘j’, and ‘u’ denotes EUC-JP, Shift_JIS, ISO-2022-JP, and UTF-8, respectively.

-x Handle XeTeX xdv file.

-h Show a help message and exit successfully.
