Actually Making an Electronic Document. Tutor: Hans Hagen. August 15th and August 22nd.

Document design, document markup, and the converging worlds of computer typesetting and electronic publishing. Tutors: Phil Taylor and Jiří Zlatuška. 16th August.

T_EX and PostScript integration. Tutor: Bogusław Jackowski. 21th August.

The tutorials are hands-on and will be held in a lab with modern PC's. The number of seats (PC's) is limited to 14. A second lab will also be available for ad-hoc usage.

Please note that tutorials are arranged in such a way that “Actually Making an Electronic Document” embraces the other two tutorials. Moreover, it embraces the whole conference. Whose who want to attend this tutorial have the option to sit in one or both other classes, thus making the most of the offer.

Registration fee for two-day tutorial is 160 USD, one-day 100 USD and includes attendance at tutorial, course notes, and coffee/tea breaks. Meals: 15 USD/day.
